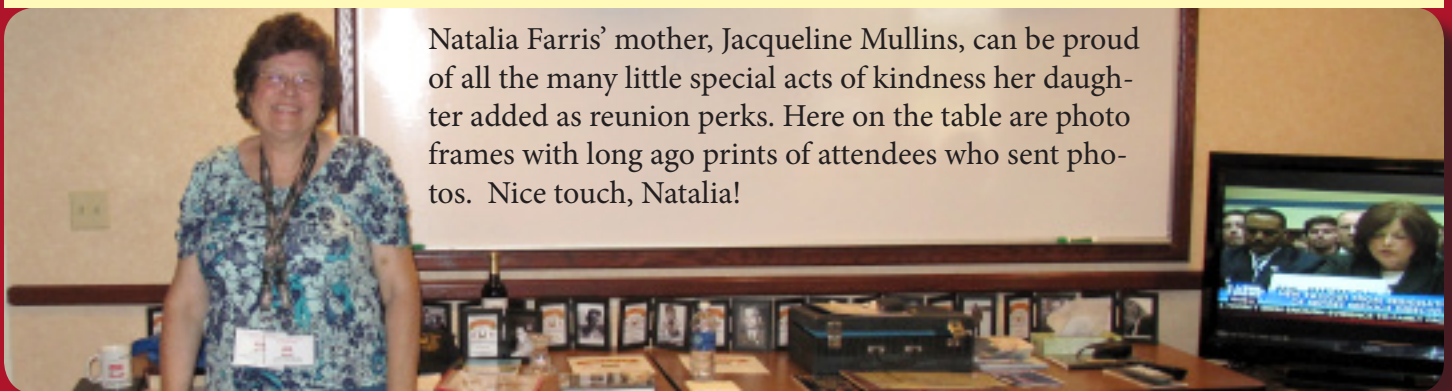

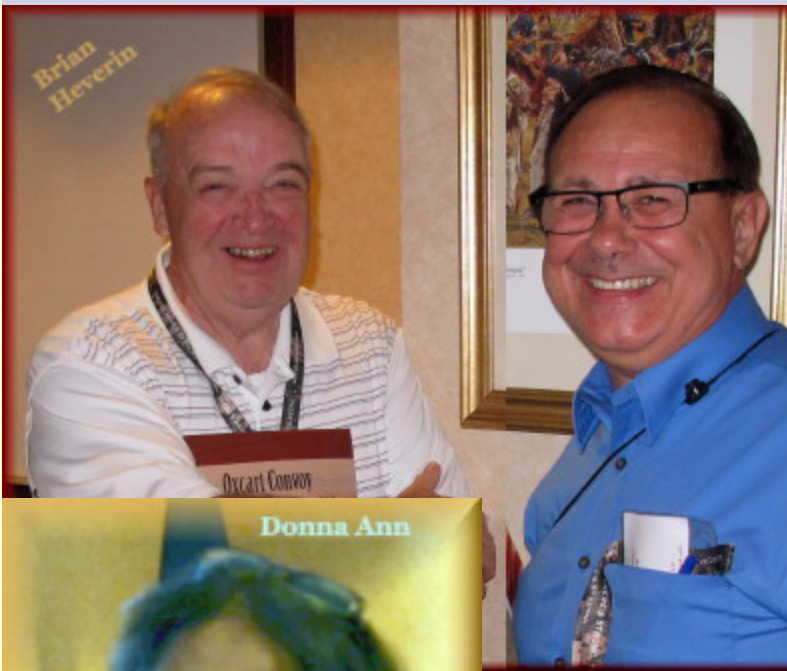

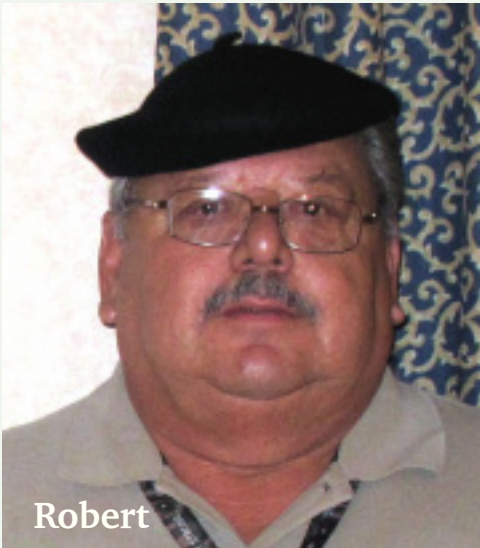


Hospitality room activity was steady from day one, and these guys helped set the tone for us in special ways. Kudos!

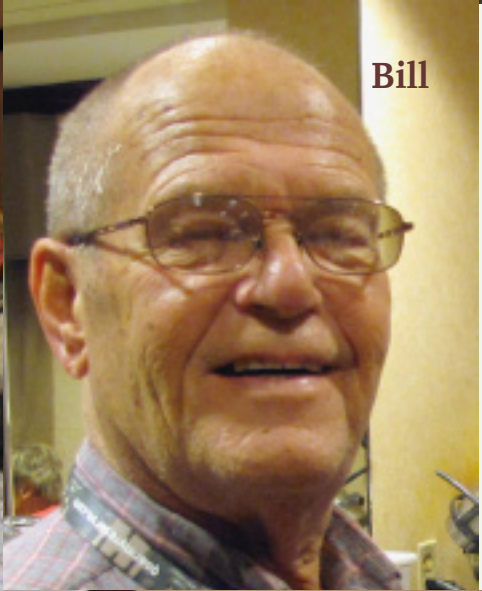

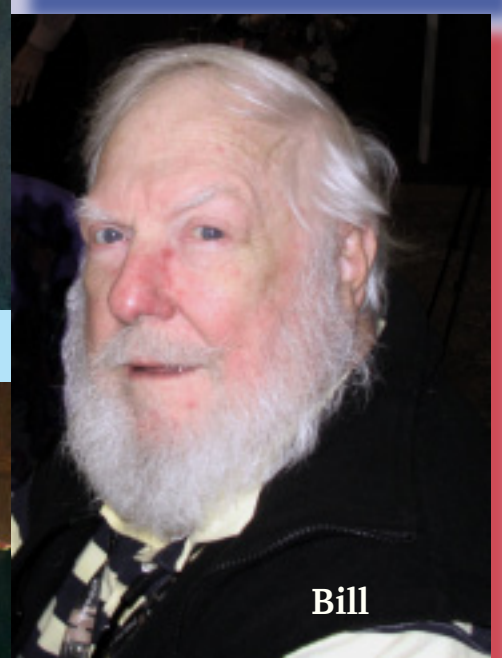

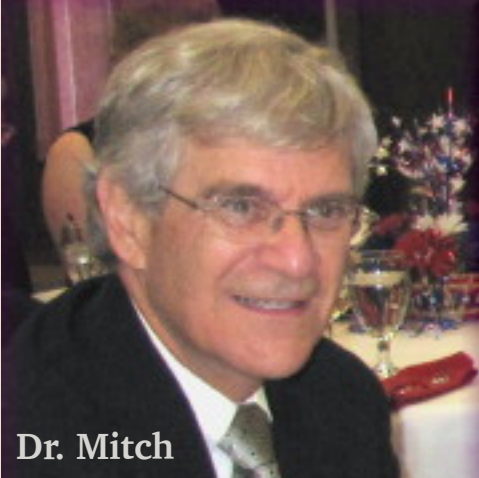
