Subj: CHANGE IN THE REUNION SCHEDULE & LOCATION

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, the 2015 All Birddog Unit Reunion is no longer being held in Panama City Beach, Florida this October 6-11 but has moved to the Ft Rucker/Dothan Alabama area for October 9-10. (The Wyndham Bay Point Resort can no longer handle our reunion event due to planned renovations and there is a lack of acceptable alternatives in the Panama City or Gulf Coast areas.) If you made a reservation at the Wyndham and/or completed the Reunion Reservation with Armed Forces Reunions (AFRI) read below. If you have NOT done either of the above but are planning on attending, there is a NEW Schedule for Friday October 9th and Saturday October 10th.

FRIDAY OCTOBER 9, 2015 – the **Birddog Memorial Dedication** will be held 11:00 am Friday October 9, 2015 at Ft Rucker, Alabama followed immediately by a special **Birddog BBQ Festival** where all units, families and friends can enjoy good southern cooking, be entertained by local musicians and experience flights in the Birddog and other selected aircraft courtesy of Friends of Army Aviation. This special event will be held in Ozark at the Blackwell Airport.

SATURDAY OCTOBER 10, 2015 - we are working on possible plans for either a large reception or a sit downdinner.

REUNION REGISTRATION REFUNDS - Armed Forces Reunions Inc. (AFRI) will begin making full refunds June 11. We have asked AFRI to delay making these refunds for 1-week to allow time for organizing the new schedule and in anticipation that AFRI may still provide service these two days. AFRI's Birddog Reunion webpage will remain active in this process.

WYNDHAM BAY POINT HOTEL RESERVATIONS - The Wyndham Bay Point Resort will commence releasing all rooms and make refunds to anyone who may have secured a room with a deposit commencing NLT Monday June 8th.

SUMMARY, no one likes sudden changes but the All Birddog Unit Reunion Committee & AFRI have worked tirelessly on your behalf since receiving the news of the Wyndham Bay Point's inability to handle our event.
